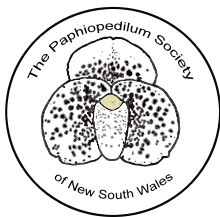

MONTHLY 5 MINUTE GROWING TIP SEGMENT

Over-wintering Paphiopedilums

Paphiopedilums are known as Tropical Slipper Orchids to distinguish them from predominantly cold-growing Cypripediums. Cypripediums are highly seasonal in their growth cycles but Paphs are very much evergreen plants even though a growth cycle and flowering period is clearly evident for most of them. The vast majority hail from warm temperate zones but many species are cold-tolerant as they derive from medium to higher elevations. Being tropical species of mostly humid environs, they are normally perpetually in active growth regulated by cycles determined by availability of water, occasional low temperatures or high heat and flowering cycles.

Virtually all Paphiopedilum species and hybrids will grow well in "intermediate" conditions or at least tolerate them. Growth stops when temperature drops into the low teens or rises beyond 30oC.

There are fundamentally two choices in overwintering Paphiopedilum. The first is simply to allow the plants to become essentially "dormant". Dormancy is protective against harsh conditions. When the temperature falls below the low teens, water should be gradually withdrawn so that water should be applied simply to prevent the plants shriveling. This may be weekly or even less. The idea is to avoid conditions becoming both cold and wet at the same time. A humid environment such as an enclosed space to avoid cold desiccating winds is necessary. The floors can be dampened in the mornings and plants watered only on warm days, avoiding water in the crowns for prolonged periods.

Alternatively, Paphs can be maintained over winter, in growth. This is particularly recommended for very young plants as it reduces time to maturity and avoids death of the plants which are slow or fail to reinitiate growth after dormancy. Growth can be maintained by supplying a little heat and increased daylength with artificial lighting. Paphs in general are not "high light plants", so the intensity of lighting need not be very great. The extension of the winter "day" up to 12 hours greatly helps in keeping the plants moving along. Watering and feeding can be maintained while the plants are in growth and it is possible to reduce the time required for flowering quite significantly with the use of a little bottom heat to maintain a temperature above 12oC and timed LED lighting to augment the daylength up to 12 hour duration. Freshly deflasked seedlings greatly benefit from this.

WHAT HAPPENED THIS MONTH

THE ORCHID QUEEN GOWAN WINS THE TOP PRIZE AT ST IVES WITH HER KING

For avid plant collectors across the country Gowan Stewart is known more commonly known as 'The Queen', due to her social media name 'Queen Plants'. At this year's 2024 St Ives Orchid Show, Gowan proved that she is most deserving of the title.

Gowan has for a number of years now, entered a table top display at the show that never fails to impress the judges, her 2024 entry was no exception. It was the orchid placed just left of center in the display that caught the attention of the judges. Gowan's Paph. *rothschildianum* was awarded Grand Champion of the Show in addition to Champion Exotic Species.

There will be a long line up for a division of this plant when and if the day finally comes. The plant also won the top prize, and a plethora of others, at last year's Orchid Central Show. Top it all off, the judges awarded the plant an FCC with the Australian Orchid Council, a spectacular achievement for Gowan.

To complete the successes at St Ives, Gowan also won Champion Vandaceous/Phalaenopsis Hybrid and 1st Place in the Table Top Display class.

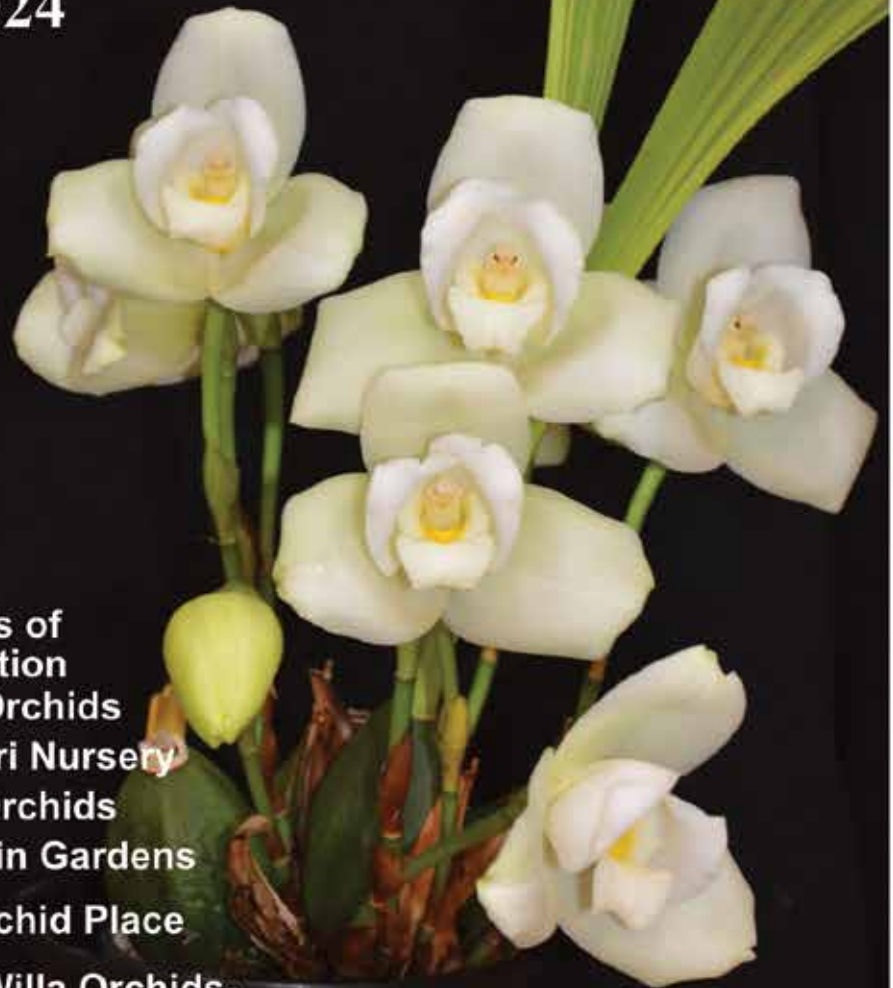

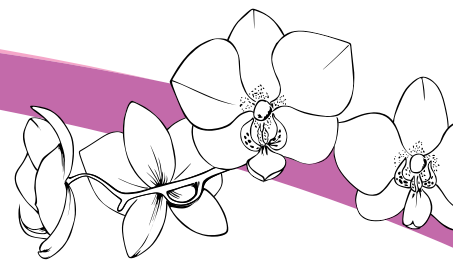
