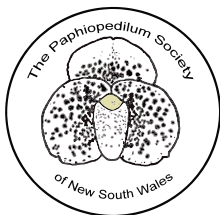

MONTHLY 5 MINUTE GROWING TIP SEGMENT - ROD NURTHEN

LIGHT REQUIREMENTS FOR OPTIMUM RESULTS

Rod mentioned that to get the optimum results from your plants, due consideration should be given to lighting, and not just fertilization to boost growth. This is his explanation....

One of the many questions I get from new orchid growers is what I feed my paphiopedilums with. They want to know what the best nutrient solution is to feed their plants to get the best growth. I think that many of them miss the point that light is the most important growth factor in plants. Unlike animals who get their energy from food, plants get their energy from light.

The question then becomes how I feed my plants the maximum amount of light. Paphiopedilums are orchids that require relatively low light levels. I find about 8,000 lux (800 foot candles) to be good for standard Paphs. If you increase the intensity of the light to increase their uptake of energy you damage the plant.

The only way to increase the energy and hence growth is to increase the number of hours of light your plants receive each day. Paphiopedilums in the natural state are mostly found between the two tropics and do not have the short winter day length we have in Sydney winters.

I have found that installing LED gro-lights in my orchid houses I can provide light when shade from trees cast a shadow and can increase the day length to 12 hours. I have found this to be beneficial to the growth of my plants.

TONIGHTS PRESENTATION

Two panels of 4 judges provided their insights and thoughts on ranking the Class winners. During the discussions, cultural and hybridising elements were highlighted to give a better insight into each specimen benched. Gowen Stewart concluded the session by explaining her cultural conditions and potting technique with reference to her award winning Paph. *rothschildianum* (FCC/AOC).

WHAT'S HAPPENING

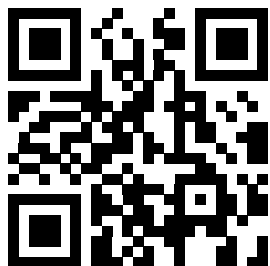
THE QUEEN TAKES ON THE SMALL SCREEN!

I was privileged enough to be able to judge, what is for me, the best Paph *micranthum* I have ever seen, in fact, I believe possibly one of, if not the best, paphiopedilum I have seen!

At the last S.P.E.C.I.E.S. meeting we were presented with two *micranthums*, one an easily awardable variety *eburneum*, this was of excellent quality, very big, well shaped, and well defined colour! On any other given day this easily would have been given the gong! However this was not a normal day, just to the left and behind, was a type form *micranthum* that in every aspect was 10 to 15 percent bigger and better in shape and colour. The petals and sepals large and overlapping. And the lip looking ever so much like a bubble gum bubble, teetering on the edge of eruption. This was going to be an easy award to give, it really was a question of how many points it was going to get? The outcome, 7 judges average score's granted what was a very high 89 points!

It is not everyday we get to see a plant of this high quality, or be able to grant it an award equally deserving of its beauty!

Congratulations to Seong Tay for cultivating yet another superb paphiopedilum specimen. Thank you to Peter & Jane D'Olier for sharing photos of the plant taken during the judging process.

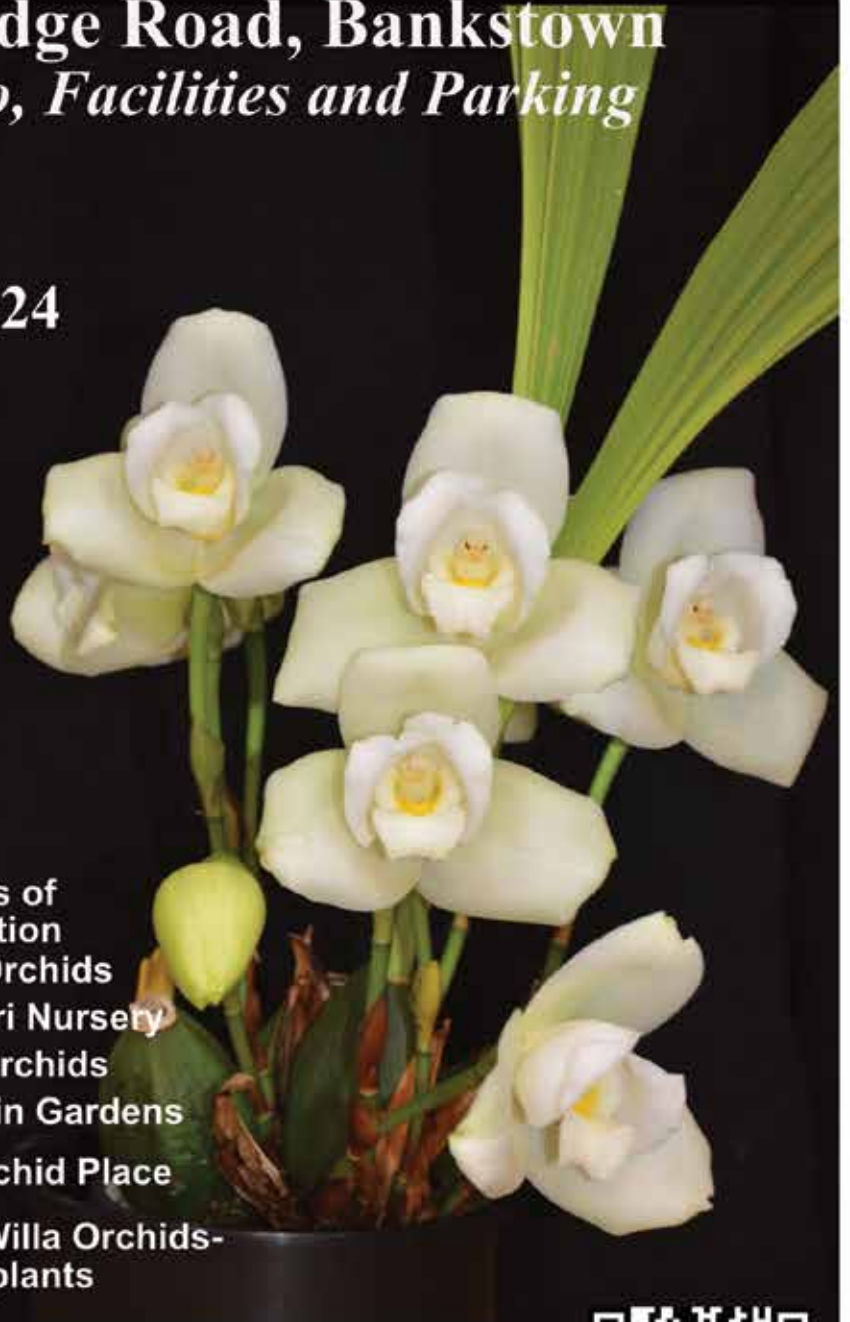

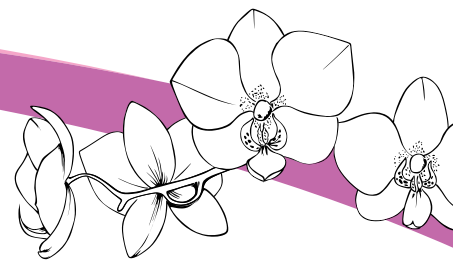
